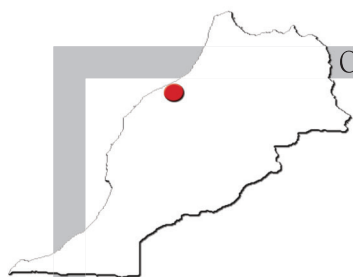

BACKGROUND

Known to be the leading winery in the renaissance of Morocco's wine industry, the vineyards of Thalvin - Domaine Ouled Thaleb, are located in Zenata, the coastal region of Morocco. Enhanced by the warm rays of the Moroccan sun, the constitution of its soil, the use of sustainable farming methods and the handpicking of the grapes. The resulting traditional winemaking approach has led to the creation of the best of Moroccan wines, and provide a diverse range of wines, each created with a stylistic approach, unique blends and settled notes.

GRAPES

100% Chardonnay

VINEYARD

AOG Zenata Our Chardonnay grapes are carefully selected from the north eastern part of Rommani Vineyards, an area of rolling hills with dark black clay soil called Tirs. Vinified and bottled at the Domaine Ouled Thaleb in Benslimane. All vineyards are ploughed and weeded by hand and no herbicide or fungicide treatments are used.

AGEING

Aged in French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES


Gold and bright in color. Baked apple and caramel, lemon meringue on the nose with the oak coming through with vanilla and nutmeg. Finishes round, rich, textural with buttery and toasted notes. A voluptuous wine.
